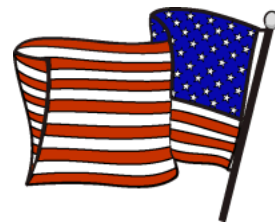

Literature or stickers, political, business or otherwise **can not** be distributed.

Non-local or non-incumbent political personalities are encouraged to participate in the following manner:

- a) Ride a float displaying or observing a Vermont theme.
- b) March or ride with immediate family plus three (3) participants.

Length of floats and/or marching units shall not exceed 125 feet. Height is limited to 12 feet.

A copy of the parade line-up will be mailed to you, after acceptance and confirmation, by July 31, 2010.
